Duration

A one day course consisting of theory and practical work.

Syllabus

By the end of the course delegates will be able to:

Understand current regulations
Identify hazards when working at height
Identify the appropriate equipment requirements
Identify the required PPE
Understand how to plan working at height
Understand safe systems of work
Understand safe working procedures
Use, Inspect and maintain rescue equipment
Understand and prepare an emergency rescue plan

- Suspension Trauma
- Rescue provisions
